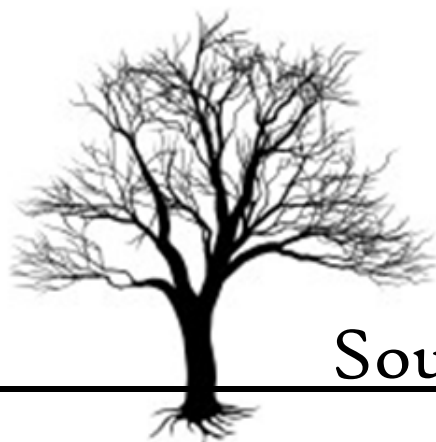


The Anne Frank Tree
